Growing with God

Bible Reading: Luke 8:5-8

⁵ 'A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up. ⁶ Some fell on rocky ground, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture. ⁷ Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants. ⁸ Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and yielded a crop, a hundred times more than was sown.'

When he said this, he called out, 'Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear.'

This is a parable about growth. The man represents God and the see is His message. Just as a planted seed starts to grow, the word of God starts to deepen and grow within a person. As we make tissue paper flowers today, lets reflect on how the word of God is growing within us.

Prayers (Mothers Union August midday prayers)

Coffee, Cake & Craft Craft: make tissue flowers



You need: tissue paper, scissors, stapler

Instructions:



TISSUE PAPER FLOWERS



• Stack several layers of tissue paper neatly in front of you (5 inches = 4 layers, 8 inches = 5 layers)

• Starting at the short end, accordion fold 1 inch sections of the tissue paper until the whole length of the tissue paper is folded together.

- Secure the centre using a stapler. Be sure the staple goes through all layers of the tissue paper.
- Use scissors to shape both ends of the tissue paper. (different shapes give different flowers)
- Fan out the folds and begin separating each layer. Fluff and shape the flower until it looks pretty.
